

SUMMARY OF HOLY WEEK SERVICES AT ST DUNSTAN'S

You are invited to join in our worship for Holy Week, the most special week in the Christian year, marking the eight days from Jesus' arrival in Jerusalem, to His betrayal and arrest, His execution, and finally His glorious rising from the dead. Services are at St Dunstan's unless specified.

Palm Sunday (29th March)

10am: Palm Sunday Eucharist with Procession

We recall Jesus' entry into Jerusalem with a procession around the grounds for those who wish to join in, followed by our Sunday Eucharist.

6pm: Evensong (St Peter's Owlswick)

Monday of Holy Week (30th March)

7.30pm: *The Dream of the Rood* Poetry Recital | 8.20pm (approx.): Compline

This beautiful Anglo-Saxon poem is read by Caroline Godden using a mixture of the original Old English and modern language, together with an introduction to the poem. The recital is then followed by Compline.

Tuesday of Holy Week (31st March)

7.30pm: Compline

A short ancient service of prayer that marks the end of the day.

Wednesday of Holy Week (1st April)

7.30pm: Stations of the Cross

A meditative service marking the key moments in Jesus' final hours.

Maundy Thursday (2nd April)

7.30pm: Eucharist of the Lord's Supper & Watch

We commemorate the Last Supper, and then mark Jesus' time in Gethsemane and the scattering of the disciples.

Come and experience the beauty of this journey with Jesus, through life and death and to the dawning of life eternal.

Good Friday (3rd April)

11am: Churches Together Service (Duke Street Gardens, Princes Risborough)

We walk from St Dunstan's at 10.30am, or gather in Duke Street Gardens at 11am, to worship with our friends from across Risborough.

2pm: Commemoration of the Lord's Passion

A solemn service of worship and thanksgiving, with Holy Communion.

Holy Saturday (4th April)

8pm: Easter Vigil

We begin our celebration of Easter with this beautiful service, journeying from darkness to light, as we celebrate Jesus rising from the dead and His light scattering the darkness.

Easter Day (5th April)

6.30am: Churches Together Sunrise Service (Whiteleaf Hill)

Welcome Easter morning with this sunrise service with friends from other churches across Risborough.

8am: BCP Holy Communion

A simple service according to the Book of Common Prayer.

10am: All-Age Eucharist

Our principal celebration of Jesus' resurrection.

6pm: Evensong (St Peter's Owlswick)

As evening draws in, we continue hearing of Jesus' appearances after His resurrection.
